

GENERAL MILESTONES

April, 23 1930 – established Leningrad Institute of Economic and Finance (LFEI)

June, 26 1930 – established Leningrad Institute of Economics and Engineering (LIEI)

September, 21 1991 – LFEI became St. Petersburg University of Economics and Finance

1992 – LIEI became St. Petersburg State Academy of Economics and Engineering (SPbGIEA)

2000 – SpBGIEA was renamed to St. Petersburg State University of Economics and Engineering











2012 SAINT-PETERSBURG IS ESTABLISHED







MAIN BUILDING OF THE UNIVERSITY AS A HERITAGE ASSET

- Decree of Catherine II from August, 8 1782 "On the beginning of construction of a building for the Assignation bank and on setting that purpose a special expedition"
 - First Assignation bank of Russia was built in 1783-1790
 - Architect Jacomo Quarenghi
 - From 1799 to 1805 the building was used also as the mint
 - 1860 established State Imperial Bank
 - 1930 the building is granted to the Leningrad Institute of Economics and Finance

• 2019 – launched a master programme "Oil and gas trading"










